The Duke ADHD Program is part of the Department of Psychiatry at the Duke University Medical Center. We are a clinical, research, and training program.

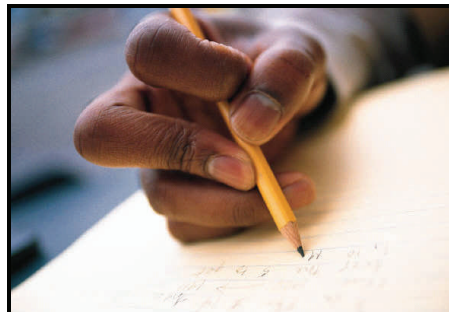
